

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to review and approve the permanent use of approximately 6,824 square feet (0.157 acre) for right-of-way and approximately 2,832 square feet (0.065 acre) for a temporary staging area to allow construction of a new bridge over Bull Creek for the Lakewood Drive Low Water Crossing at Bull Creek Project through dedicated parkland known as the Bull Creek Park; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public meeting to be held on April 2, 2009, 2008, was given for three consecutive weeks on March 8, March 15, and March 22, 2009 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held on April 2, 2009, by the City Council to consider the permanent use of parkland for a right-of-way and temporary use for a staging area; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council finds that, having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the parkland (detailed in the attached Exhibit "A") to provide permanent right-of-way and a temporary staging area, and the conveyance of the parkland for such proposed use is approved.

The City Council finds that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the parkland from the resulting use.

The City Manager is authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable or required.
