

Bid documents were distributed to 15 general contractors. Engineer's estimated cost for this project is \$6,870,493. Bids were opened on February 5, 2009. National Power Rodding Corporation submitted the lowest of six bids received:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for four areas of subcontracting opportunities: Hauling Services, Site Work, Fuel Oil and Diesel, and Maintenance and Repair of Sewer and Storm Drain.

Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 0.78% African American; 3.25% Hispanic; 0.38% Native/Asian; 3.77% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$4,465,197.04:
