

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY RELOCATION OF THE PEOPLE'S RENAISSANCE MARKET VENDORS TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE 500 BLOCK OF 24TH STREET FROM JUNE 1, 2009 TO JULY 1, 2009 DURING THE 23RD STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The location of the People's Renaissance Market established by City Code Chapter 14-2, Article 2 (*People's Renaissance Market*), is closed for the period of June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2009 to facilitate streetscape improvements.

PART 2. During the temporary closure established in Part 1 of this ordinance, the People's Renaissance Market shall be open during its normal business hours, as established by Section 14-2-14, at the following temporary location:

the south sidewalk beginning three feet south of the south curb along the 24th Street (West) right-of-way between 20 feet west of Guadalupe Street and 20 feet east of San Antonio Street, excluding the alley and the entrance to any business fronting the south side of 24th Street, for a distance of seven feet.

PART 3. All other applicable requirements and procedures of City Code Chapter 14-2, Article 2 (*People's Renaissance Market*) apply to the temporary area described in Part 2 of this ordinance in the same manner as if the area was identified in Section 14-2-15 (*Street Closure and Authorized Use*) of the City Code.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on _____, 2009.
