SUBJECT:	2009 Juneteenth Parade

This item on the May 21, 2009 Council Agenda, to approve waiver of certain fees and requirements under City Code Chapter 4-3 and 14-7 and authorize payment of certain costs for the City's annual cosponsorship of the Greater East Austin Youth Association's 2009 Juneteenth Parade and Celebration to be held on June 19, 2009, at Rosewood Park., will have the following fiscal impact:

Summary of fee waivers, reimbursements, and payments authorized*:

- \$10,935 Parks and Recreation Department
- \$3,716.67 Solid Waste Services
- \$2,790 Emergency Medical Services
- \$3,326 Watershed Protection and Development Review (Right-of-Way)
- \$880 Watershed Protection and Development Review

\$21,647.67 Total waivers, reimbursements, and payments authorized

In summary, total fees waivers, reimbursements, and payments authorized are \$21,647.67. In addition, the Signature Requirement and the requirement for Security Deposit for Right-of-Way, \$2,000, and the Damage Deposit for Parks and Recreation Department, \$2,000, are also being waived. Any fee requirements and other costs above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

This is one of the city co-sponsored special events per Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
