ORDINANCE NO. 20090514-034

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE AUSTIN POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAINING ACADEMY, LOCATED AT 4800 SHAW LANE, AS THE ROY BÙTLER POLICE TRAINING ACADEMY; AND WAIVING APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 14-1 OF THE CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that:

- (A) Roy Butler served as Austin's first elected Mayor, from 1971 to 1975.
- (B) He always made public safety a priority during his tenure.
- (C) Mr. Butler was one of the original founders of the Greater Austin Crime Commission, which has provided direct support to the Austin Police Department for over 12 years.
- (D) He served on the special called Training Committee after the Cedar Street incident.
- (E) He served on the Police Training Monitoring Committee.
- (F) He was one of the first citizens selected to serve on the Police Citizen Review Panel.
- (G) Roy Butler is a member of the Public Safety Taskforce.
- **PART 2.** The Training Academy of the Austin Police Department, located at 4800 Shaw Lane, is named the "Roy Butler Police Training Academy" in honor of Roy Butler's long and distinguished service to the City of Austin and his dedication to public safety.
- **PART 3.** The Council waives facility naming requirements of Chapter 14-1 of the City Code related to the naming of the Training Academy of the Austin Police Department.
- **PART 4.** This ordinance takes effect on May 25, 2009.
