

Bid documents were distributed to nine general contractors. Bids were opened on April 23, 2009. Muniz Concrete & Contracting, Inc. submitted the lowest of three bids received:

Muniz Concrete & Contracting, Inc., Austin, TX	\$166,240.00
Lehne Construction, Inc., Austin, TX	\$214,130.00
Gibson & Associates, Inc., Balch Springs, TX	\$241,415.00

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides one area of subcontracting opportunity: bridge and pedestrian railing.

Project specific goals stated in the solicitation were 8.50% MBE and 4.97% WBE. Total participation is estimated on base bid amount of \$166,240.00:

74.29% Non M/WBE prime participation; 11.92% MBE and 13.79% WBE subcontractor participation.

THIRD BIDDER - Gibson & Associates, Inc., Balch Springs, TX - \$241,415.00

94.71% Non M/WBE prime participation; 0.77% MBE and 4.52% WBE; subcontractor participation.
