**Subject:** Authorize award and execution of a contract with APPLIED BIOSYSTEMS, Foster City, CA for the purchase of a genetic analyzer for the Austin Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$88,923.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding is available in the Austin Police Special Revenue Fund, 2008 Forensic DNA Backlog Reduction Grant 2008-DN-BX-K022.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

**MBE/WBE:** This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9D of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract is for the purchase of a capillary electrophoresis machine, 3130 Genetic Analyzer, that allows for four DNA samples to be analyzed simultaneously compared to the current machine that only allows for one sample to be analyzed at a time.

This process is used to develop a DNA profile from a previously amplified DNA extract and will be used by the DNA lab and DNA analysts. This process is required for every DNA sample that is processed in the Austin Police Department's DNA laboratory.

All of the genetic analyzers currently in service at the Austin Police Department's DNA laboratories are purchased from Applied Biosystems in order to maintain consistent laboratory certifications and the validation of procedures required by the criminal justice system. Applied Biosystems has no authorized agents, distributors, or dealers for its instruments systems, consumable products, or services.

This purchase will be funded by the 2008 National Institute of Justice Forensic DNA Backlog Reduction grant for DNA laboratories.
