## Public Works RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

**Subject:** Authorize negotiation and execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City and Travis County for relocation of Austin Water Utility water lines as part of the County's Imperial Valley Drive Project, in the amount of \$115,730 plus a \$28,930 contingency, for a not to exceed amount of \$144,660.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Approved Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission.

Travis County's improvements to Imperial Valley Drive will require relocation of existing Austin Water Utility facilities. The City and County will include the construction of the waterline relocations in the County's Project.

The City will place the City's funds into a County escrow account within 21 days after the County's notification to the City of the successful bidder and the bid amount. This amount is currently estimated at \$115,730.

The City agrees to pay all costs of inspection and testing of the City Project and agrees to reimburse the County all construction costs of the City Project including the cost of any change orders made necessary by field changes to address unanticipated conditions under the terms and conditions in this Agreement. The County shall obtain written approval from the City for all change order requests prior to the County issuing the approved change order to the contractor.
