Bid documents were distributed to two general contractors. Bids were opened on May 14, 2009. Viking Construction Inc. submitted the lower of two bids received. However, their bid was deemed "non-compliant" by the City's Small and Minority Business Resources Department due to their lack of contact with any African American vendors and inadequate good faith efforts.
