BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:


The City Manager is directed to procure a consultant team with experience in the development of local and regional multi-modal, build-able, strategic mobility plans including experience with:

- Coordination with multiple jurisdictions such as CAMPO, CTRMA, TxDOT, Travis County, Capital Metro and other appropriate jurisdictions;
- An outreach process to all community stakeholders that is open and accessible throughout the plan development and transparent to the citizens of the community; and

- To include the development of a cohesive set of options for near term, low-cost mobility improvements.
