## Purchasing Office RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

**Subject:** Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with TEXANA MACHINERY CORPORATION, Manor, TX to provide repair services and parts for Case heavy equipment in an estimated amount not to exceed \$315,250, with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$115,763 for the first extension option, \$121,551 for the second extension option, and \$127,628 for the third extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$680,192.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding in the amount of \$16,667 is available in the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Division of the Financial and Administrative Services Department. Funding for the remaining 34 months of the original contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

**Fiscal Note:** There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

**MBE/WBE:** This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide repair services and parts on an as needed basis for City-owned Case heavy road equipment. This repair services contract is intended to supplement the Case heavy road equipment repairs performed by the City's mechanics in six automotive Fleet Service Centers.

The City currently has seven units of Case heavy equipment in the Fleet inventory. This contract is necessary to support the automotive and equipment Fleet Service Centers with a reliable and continuous repair source.
