AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12-5 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO CIVIL FINES, COSTS AND FEES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Subsection 12-5-89(E) (Civil Fines, Costs and Fees) of the City Code is amended to read:
