## RESOLUTION NO.

**WHEREAS,** Council has adopted water conservation strategies to reach its goal of reducing peak day water use by 1 percent per year for 10 years; and

**WHEREAS,** There is significant public interest in further reducing Austin's water consumption; and

WHEREAS, On December 6, 2007, the City Council approved a Citizen's Water Conservation Implementation Task Force whose membership includes environmental advocates, development advocates, irrigators, and others with expertise and interest in water conservation; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Citizen's Water Conservation Implementation Task Force ("Task Force") is hereby directed to recommend additional water conservation measures to further reduce water use beyond the 2007 Task Force recommendations.

- The Task Force shall work with City staff, the Resource Management Commission, Environmental Board, and Water and Wastewater Commission to produce a policy document that recommends these additional conservation measures for future water use in the City of Austin.
- 2. The Task Force shall meet at least monthly.

- 3. The Task Force shall report to the City Council with an update on progress not later than November 5, 2009.
- 4. The Task Force shall present the final policy document to City Council on or before January 1, 2010.

## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The City Manager is hereby directed to work with the Task Force and provide all necessary data and resources to meet the goals of this resolution.
