## ORDINANCE NO. 20090806-032

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 2-3-9 RELATING TO THE COUNCIL AUDIT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE AND SECTION 2-10-5 RELATING TO THE JUDICIAL COMMITTEE.

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** City Code Subsection 2-3-9(A) (*Council Audit and Finance Committee*) is amended to read:

 (A) The council audit and finance committee is created. The committee consists of <u>five [four]</u> council members selected by the council.

PART 2. City Code Section 2-10-5 (Judicial Committee) is amended to read:

## § 2-10-5 JUDICIAL COMMITTEE.

- (A) Council shall appoint <u>three</u> [two] of its members to the Judicial Committee to provide oversight and direction to the presiding judge and the municipal court clerk.
- (B) [The mayor is a permanent member of the Judicial Committee and serves as chair. (C)] The Judicial Committee shall consult with the municipal judges and develop and adopt performance criteria for an evaluation required under Section 2-10-11(B)(10) (*Presiding Judge*).
- (D) The Judicial Committee shall evaluate the performance of the presiding judge and a judge appointed to the Downtown Austin Community Court.
- (E) [(D)] The Judicial Committee shall set the hours of work and assign the duties of a judge appointed to the Downtown Austin Community Court. The mayor or, in the mayor's absence, the mayor pro tem, shall schedule and approve leave for a judge appointed to the Downtown Austin Community Court.
