Austin Finance Corporation "Holly Good Neighbor", Home Repair Program Eligibilty

Program Purpose:

The purpose of the Holly Plant/Austin Energy Grant is to improve the Holly neighborhood surrounding the power plant by providing resources to residents to repair and rehabilitate their Homes.

Requirements:

- 1. fill out a complete application
- 2. 100% Area Median Family Income (AMFI)
- 3. Restrict participation to residents who can demonstrate that they (or an immediate family member) owned the Home in 2000.
- 4. Activities costing less than \$5,000 will be provided as grants.

 Activities costing between \$10,000 and \$30,000 (the program funding limit) will be provided as a 7 year deferred, forgivable loan.
- 5. Eligible homeowners may apply for services not previously received up to program cap.
- 6. Total property values may not exceed Austin's 203 (b) limits. As of February 2009, the 203 (b) limit AHFC must follow is \$218,595.00
- 7. Program Options:
 - a. Plumbing repairs, Electrical repairs, Roofing repairs, Foundation repairs, Exterior Painting, Home conversion to Solar Energy

Holly Decommission Committee "Holly Good Neighbor", Home Repair Program Eligibility Recommendations: Requirements:

- 1. Fill out a complete application
- 2 Restrict participation to residents who can demonstrate that they (or an immediate family member) owned the home in 2000.
- 3. Senior Citizens 55 & over and the Disabled
- 4. Activities costing less than \$10,000 will be provided as Grants.

 Activities costing between \$10,000 and \$40,000 will be provided as a 5 year—deferred, forgivable loan.
- 5 Eligible homeowners may apply for services not previously received up to program cap.
- 6 Program Options:
 - a. Plumbing repair, Electrical repairs, Rooting repairs, Foundation repairs, Exterior Painting and Home Conversion to Solar Energy
- 7. Return to Home replacement 15 year forgivable loan, on a per case basis.
