WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas first designated the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Austin region in 1973, referred to then as the "Austin Transportation Study Policy Advisory Committee" and later named the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, known as CAMPO; and

WHEREAS, since the early 1990s the City of Austin has served as the fiscal agent for CAMPO; and

WHEREAS, the City of Austin and CAMPO have previously entered into agreements specifying terms and conditions under which the City of Austin provides certain fiscal, personnel and property management services to CAMPO; and

WHEREAS, the existing agreement was signed in 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the CAMPO Transportation Policy Board hereby votes to authorize the Chair to negotiate and execute a Fiscal, Personnel and Property Management Agreement with the City of Austin; and

Hereby orders the recording of this resolution in the minutes of the Transportation Policy Board; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board delegates the signing of necessary documents to the Board Chair.
