WHEREAS, H.B. No. 216 of the 81st Texas Legislature relating to local

regulation of certain establishments that provide housing and at least one

additional qualifying service for elderly or disabled persons was signed into law

by the governor of Texas on June 19, 2009; and

WHEREAS, H.B. No. 216 requires the Executive Commissioner of the

State Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to develop and publish

in the Texas Register model standards for the operation of such establishments

not later than September 1, 2010 (and potentially much sooner); and

WHEREAS, local regulation of such establishments furthers an important

public purpose of promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Austin

and its inhabitants, including elderly and disabled members of the community;

and

WHEREAS, proactive planning will better position the City to implement

local regulations more rapidly following state publication of applicable model

standards; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager is directed to pursue opportunities to directly

communicate and work with HHSC as model standards for local regulation of

qualifying establishments are developed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

The City Manager is directed to promptly assess relevant model standards

and to recommend to council a potential program to administer permitting and

locally regulate such establishments, including informing council of the

anticipated fiscal impact of adding new City responsibilities required for

implementation and maintenance of such a program. To the extent feasible,

based on the date of the publication by HHSC of the model standards, the

proposed permitting and regulatory program shall be available for council

consideration in the FY 2011-2012 City budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

The City Manager shall periodically update the Public Health and Human

Services Committee regarding status as HHSC develops model standards for the

operation of qualified residential establishments as envisioned by H.B. No. 216.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

The City Manager is directed to consider, and to offer to collaborate with

Travis County to develop, a potential interlocal permitting and regulatory

program for qualifying residential establishments as contemplated by H.B. No.

216.
