Subject: Authorize execution of Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Sunset Valley for the Brodie Lane and William Cannon Drive Intersection Improvements Project to add a termination date of December 31, 2010.

Prior Council Action: March 3, 2005 Approval of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Austin and the City of Sunset Valley; April 28, 2005 Approval of an ordinance to accept funds from the City of Sunset Valley

On March 3, 2005, City Council approved an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Austin and the City of Sunset Valley for potential improvements to the intersection of Brodie Lane and William Cannon Drive. As part of this Interlocal Agreement, the City of Sunset Valley will fund the Brodie Lane and William Cannon Drive Intersection Improvements Project and the City of Austin will manage the project from the Preliminary Phase through completion.

On April 28, 2005, City Council approved an ordinance to accept \$300,000 from the City of Sunset Valley and to amend the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Public Works Department Capital Budget of Ordinance No. 040913-02 to create a new project entitled "Brodie Lane and William Cannon Drive Intersection Improvements Project" and to appropriate \$300,000 for the project.

To date, the City of Sunset Valley has provided the City of Austin with \$46,347 toward the Brodie Lane and William Cannon Drive Intersection Improvements Project and \$45,445 was used to fund a Preliminary Engineering Report. The Preliminary Engineering Report was presented to the City of Sunset Valley on December 15, 2005 and since that date the City of Sunset Valley has not taken any action on the project. Both parties agree that establishing a termination date of December 31, 2010 allows sufficient time for the City of Sunset Valley to decide upon a course of action.
