Subject: Permanent and Temporary Use of Parkland

Attached is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that outlines the conditions and mitigation plan for Lady Bird Lake/4th Street Drainage Improvements – Holly Shores, that meets the Parks and Recreation Department's conditional approval for Permanent and Temporary use of parkland, located at Lady Bird Lake, 2615 Canterbury. Mitigation for the use of parkland has been calculated as follows:

Permanent Use: 136 sq. ft. at \$663.00

Temporary Use: 5,611 sq. ft. at \$2,930.75

Total Amount of Mitigation value to PARD = \$3,593.75

Mitigation Fees are waived, as the work performed is a direct improvement to parkland

This MOU was recommended for approval by the Parks and Recreation Board on September 22, 2009.

After the review and recommendation by the Parks and Recreation Board, a Chapter 26 public hearing will be held before the City Council for final approval.
