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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 14-1-32 AND 14-1-33 OF THE CODE REGARDING THE NAMING OF A FACILITY AND NAMING THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES LEVANDER LOOP CAMPUS LOCATED AT 7201 LEVANDER LOOP, AUSTIN, TEXAS, THE BETTY DUNKERLEY CAMPUS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Findings.

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- A) Mayor Pro Tem Betty Dunkerley is a long time Central Texas community leader, providing credible service to the Austin community and the City of Austin.
 - (B) As an Austin City Council member Mayor Pro Tem Betty Dunkerley had a profound role in shaping the direction of Austin in many dimensions,
 - (C) Mayor Pro Tem Betty Dunkerley was instrumental in the formation of the Travis County Health Care District.
 - (D) Mayor Pro Tem Dunkerley was the Chief Financial Officer for the City of Austin.
 - (E) Mayor Pro Tem Dunkerley was committed to ensuring high-quality health care for all.
 - (F) While Assistant City Manager, Mayor Pro Tem Dunkerley oversaw the Health and Human Services Department.

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PART 2. The requirements of Sections 14-1-32 (*Naming Policy*) and 14-1-33 (*Procedures for Naming a Facility*) of the Code are waived for the naming of the Health and Human Services Levander Loop Campus located at 7201 Levander Loop, Austin, Texas.

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PART 3. The Health and Human Services Levander Loop Campus is named the Betty Dunkerley Campus.
