

ORDINANCE NO. 20091217-089

AN ORDINANCE ENCOURAGING SUPPORT OF LEMONADE DAY AUSTIN 2010 ON MAY 2, 2010; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A TEMPORARY FOOD PERMIT UNDER CITY CODE CHAPTER 10-3; AND WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A LICENSE AGREEMENT UNDER CHAPTER 14-11.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Findings.

- (A) In 2007, Prepared 4 Life, a non-profit organization, launched the "Lemonade Day" program to educate and equip young people with entrepreneurial skills.
- (B) On May 2, 2010, Entrepreneurs Foundation of Central Texas, in partnership with Prepared 4 Life, will be hosting "Lemonade Day Austin 2010" (Lemonade Day) for young entrepreneurs in Austin so local participants can learn business operation techniques by running their own lemonade stand business.
- (C) Trilogy Employees Foundation is the title sponsor for Lemonade Day.
- (D) Lemonade Day complements other prominent youth-focused organizations, including, but not limited to, the Austin YMCA, Girl Scouts of Central Texas, Boys and Girls Clubs of the Austin Area, Con Mi Madre and the People Fund.
- (E) Providing Austin youth with quality extracurricular opportunities is a public benefit.

PART 2. Council directs the City Manager to work with staff to join the hosts, sponsors and community partners of Lemonade Day in encouraging the entire community to support participating youth entrepreneurs on May 2, 2010 by buying lemonade.

PART 3. Council directs the City Manager to work with staff to provide Lemonade Day participants space at all City parks, libraries, and fire stations where stands can be accommodated without disrupting city services.

PART 4. Council waives the requirement of Chapter 10-3 (*Food and Food Handlers*) of the City Code for a temporary food permit for Lemonade Day registered participants for May 2, 2010 only. Lemonade stands shall follow the City's temporary food service guidelines.

PART 5. Council waives the requirement of Chapter 14-11 (*Use of Right-of-Way*) of the City Code for a license agreement to use public property for Lemonade Day registered participants for May 2, 2010 only.

PART 6. This ordinance takes effect on December 28, 2009.
