ORDINANCE NO. <u>20091217-110</u>

AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE DR. WALTER BACON BLACK HOUSE LOCATED AT 401 WEST 32ND STREET IN THE NORTH UNIVERSITY NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN AREA FROM FAMILY RESIDENCE-NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION COMBINING DISTRICT-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-NCCD-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT TO FAMILY RESIDENCE-HISTORIC LANDMARK-NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION COMBINING DISTRICT-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-H-NCCD-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from family residence-neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (SF-3-NCCD-NP) combining district to family residence-historic landmark-neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (SF-3-H-NCCD-NP) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14H-2009-0037, on file at the Planning and Development Review Department, as follows:

Lots 83 and 85, Block 7, Outlot 74, Division D, Aldridge Place Subdivision, a subdivision in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, according to the map or plat of record in Plat Book 2, Page 231 of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),

generally known as the Dr. Walter Bacon Black House, locally known as 401 West 32nd Street, in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit "A".

PART 2. Except as specifically provided in Part 3 of this ordinance, the Property may be developed and used in accordance with the regulations established for the family residence (SF-3) base district and other applicable requirements of the City Code.

PART 3. The Property is subject to Ordinance No. 040826-58 that established the North University neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan combining district.
