Austin Water Utility RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Subject: Approve the issuance of a Letter of Intent for a rebate to COPPER MILL APARTMENT HOMES for the installation of up to 412 water efficient toilets at the Copper Mill Apartment Homes, in an amount not to exceed \$82,400.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Conservation Rebate and Incentives Fund.

Fiscal Note: A fiscal note is not required.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission and the Resource Management Commission.

Austin Water Utility requests authorization to issue a rebate in an amount not to exceed \$82,400 to COPPER MILL APARTMENT HOMES for the purchase and installation of up to 412 1.28 gallon, high efficiency tank-type toilets (revised from original application for 448 toilets based on pre-inspection results) at the Copper Mill Apartment Homes located at 10000 N. Lamar Blvd. Austin, TX 78753 in accordance with the City of Austin's Toilet Rebate Program guidelines. The rebate is for the cost of toilets and installation by a Texas licensed plumber up to a maximum of \$200 per toilet. The application for Copper Mill was received on October 7, 2009 prior to the suspension of the Multi-family and Commercial Toilet Rebate Program.

This program is designed to replace old large-capacity toilets with water efficient models. The replacement of these toilets is expected to save approximately an estimated 7,045 gallons per day, reducing demands on the Utility's treatment capacity and decreasing greenhouse gas equivalents by an estimated 6.35 metric tons per year.
