## Watershed Protection Department RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Item No. 55

**Subject:** Authorize negotiation and execution of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) for a volumetric survey of Lake Austin, in the total amount of \$5,157.

Prior Council Action: August 7, 2008 - Original contract for bathymetry was approved.

In August 2008 Council approved and in September 2008 the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with TWDB for a volumetric survey of Lake Austin in the amount of \$20,628. The survey, described below, has been completed, and 75% of the original Agreement amount paid to TWDB. The agreement expired before TWDB completed analysis of the survey data. This action will authorize a new Interlocal Agreement with TWDB to complete the analysis and reporting, including a 60 day review and comment period.

TWDB has performed a volumetric survey of Lake Austin, collecting bathymetric or depth measurements to develop an updated elevation-area-capacity table and associated maps, including a contour map and shaded relief plot of the lake bottom. The last bathymetric survey of this water body was conducted by TWDB in 1999, and several significant floods have occurred in the intervening period. An updated survey will provide information relating to accumulation and loss of sediment in creek deltas and along the lakeshore, as well as change in lake volume. These data are also used in locating and mapping submerged nuisance vegetation, such as hydrilla, for floodplain mapping at creek mouths, and as a frame of reference in developing detailed designs for projects involving shoreline or underwater construction.

No new funding is required for this contract, as the original funding for the complete study is still available. This Agreement applies to the portion of the original contract that has not already been paid to TWDB in the amount of \$5,157.00.
