Item #28 on the April 8, 2010 Council Agenda, to approve a resolution making the Mexican Freetailed Bat the official animal of Austin, declaring the evening of the first Sunday in June "The Night of the Bat", and amending Resolution No. 021003-40 to include "The Night of the Bat" as an annual City co-sponsored event, will have the following fiscal impact:

Fee waivers:

- \$524 Portable Toilet Fees (Parks and Recreation)
- \$2,500 Barricade Use Fees (Austin Transportation)
- \$4,400 Austin Police Department
- \$1,500 Traffic Control Plan (Austin Transportation)
- \$1,324 Staff Fees (Solid Waste Services)
- \$300 Dumpster and Equipment Use Fees (Solid Waste Services)
- \$825 Standby Fees (Emergency Medical Services)
- \$250 Application Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$100 Permit Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$76 Safety Inspection Fee (Austin Transportation)
- \$33 Sound Amplification (Austin Transportation)

\$11,832 Total Fees Waived

In summary, the total fee waivers being waived for this event are \$11,832. In addition, the refundable security deposit requirement of \$2,000 is also being waived. Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

This is being added as one of the City co-sponsored special events by amending Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
