WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for \$138,107 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division, to continue the salaries of three current grant-funded VAWA Victim Services Counselors through the project entitled Austin Police Services for Victims of Domestic Violence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for grant renewal funds for said project in the amount of \$138,107 from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division, for the project Austin Police Services for Victims of Domestic Violence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the State of

Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division in full; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the application for grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division, for the project Austin Police Services for Victims of Domestic Violence in the amount of \$138,107.
