

RESOLUTION NO. 20100408-012

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for \$450,777 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division, to provide equipment and related supplies to support the APD Clandestine Lab Response Team, and a laser scanning system to provide 3-D images of major crime scenes and fatal/serious injury collisions, entitled the "Austin Police Department Criminal Justice Program"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for grant renewal funds for said project in the amount of \$450,777 from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division, for the Austin Police Department Criminal Justice Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the State of


Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division in full; **NOW, THEREFORE,**
