2. REVIEW AND APPROVE MINUTES OF JANUARY 19, 2010 MEETING

- Committee Chair Ronda Rutledge reported on the City and County's presentation on organizational structure. No action taken

B. Food Production and Business Committee, February 8, 2010 Meeting

- Update on rooster ban
 - Committee Chair, Allison Beadle reported on the citizens meeting with Austin Rooster Supporters with Dave Sullivan with the Code Ordinance Committee on February 10, 2010 where Dick Pierce attended. The outcome is that additional research is needed on the current noise ordinance enforcement and to compile date on noise complaints. Dave Sullivan will recommend. Dave Sullivan is going to recommend at the Code Ordinance Subcommittee's meeting on February 16, 2010 to ask the Planning Commission to send a resolution to City Council asking for more research on this issue and more

enforcement on current rules. Committee Member Dick Pierce will follow-up and report to full board at the February 22, 2010 meeting.

• Update on action on the ungraded egg letter

• The Food Production and Business Committee voted to approve the letter and send to City Council. Linda Terry provided process on sending correspondence to City Council.

• Other updates by Committee Members.

- Committee Members Katie Kraemer and Max Elliott are working on water meter fee
 waiver criteria to provide the recommendations back to Rusty Cobern which are due
 back to Austin Water Utility by May and Committee Chair Allison Beadle will take
 lead.
- Committee Members Max Elliott and Paula McDermott are working on definitions on sustainable agriculture best practices by leaning on what PARD and Metro Parks have already established. No action taken
- Discussed possible resolutions that will impact the fiscal year 2011 budget and Chair Marla Camp and Committee Chair Allison Beadle will work together to research on incentives for local food production by looking at other communities and how they use incentives. No action taken.

C. Draft list of priorities for the Sustainability Officer 2011 budget

Committee Chair Allison Beadle will draft a letter to present to City Council on the priorities and responsibilities for the Sustainability Officer to be discussed at the next board meeting February 22, 2010.

D. Discuss items for recommendation to board for fiscal note on city/county upcoming budget cycle

- Executive Liaison addressed Executive Committee on the budget process.
- The item was discussed that the SFPB make recommendations in March to have City Council create policy to have, i.e. Convention Center, AIS to purchase from local sustainable farmers
- The board will be recommending 3 -5 items to be included in the budget cycle.

E. Draft formal request to staff to assist with creating a Multi-Departmental Task Team pertaining to sustainable food issues

Committee Chair Ronda Rutledge will recruit a member from the Access and Wellness Committee to draft a proposal to be sent to Executive Liaison Vince Cobalis for further internal processing. No action taken.
