NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Manvel Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the "Corporation"), a non-profit corporation created by the City of Manvel, Texas pursuant to Art. 1528m, Vernon's Civil Statutes, as amended, will hold a public hearing on June 21, 2010, commencing at 9:00 a.m. at 401 Congress Avenue, Conference Room Congress 2, 12th Floor, Austin, Texas 78701, to provide an opportunity for all interested persons to be heard with respect to a proposed loan from The Frost National Bank (the "Bank") to the Corporation in the maximum amount of up to \$6,000,000 and a proposed loan from the Corporation to Capitol Area Council, Inc. Boy Scouts of America (the "Borrower") in the same amount (collectively, the "Loans"); all pursuant to a Loan Agreement among the Corporation, the Bank and the Borrower. The Loans are being made for the purpose of (a) financing the cost of an approximate 35,625 square foot two story community facility, comprised of administrative and staff offices (the "Project") and (b) paying certain expenses in connection with the Loans. The Project is owned by the Borrower and is located at 12500 North IH-35, Southbound Frontage Road, Austin, Texas 78753. The Loans are not payable out of taxes and are payable solely from funds provided by the Borrower. All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing to express their views, both orally and in writing, with respect to the Loans and the Project.
