SPECIAL CALLED MEETING 15, June, 2010

The Library Commission convened a Special Called meeting on Monday, June 15, 2010 at the Austin History Center, 810 Guadalupe

2. New Business

- a. Approval of Library Commission's *Preserving Austin's Public Library Services* Resolution Motion to approve resolution as amended was approved on Commission Member Kobierowski's motion and Commission Member Hoffman's second on a 5-0 vote.
- b. Staff Briefing on Budget Issues The Library has prioritized three unmet needs:
 - 1. \$ 171,506 for 2.0 FTEs and 2 step vans to meet the workload of APL's Delivery Services Division
 - 2. \$250,000 for temporary employees to assure APL can keep all locations operational and meet the workload demands
 - 3. \$87,000 for downloadable materials (digital versions of music, movies and spoken books), a format in great demand by APL customers

Four budget reductions from last year have been brought back as a possibility

- 1. Morning reduction in branch hours system-wide
- 2. Evening reduction on branch hours system-wide
- 3. Reduction in Central Library hours
- 4. Reduction in the system-wide book budget
