When this OMV permit was issued, there was not in effect a temporary or conditional outdoor entertainment use permit for this property. I contend that the temporary use permit issued on 16 March 2010 allowing outdoor entertainments at this site was issued in error. The issuance of that permit is currently being appealed.
