It is imperative to upgrade our network devices to continue to keep current applications and next year's planned projects supported.
Digital Vehicular Video	\$ 4,470,000	Debt/APD CIP	This request will allow for the purchase of equipment such as PCs and toughbooks, cabling, wireless, power supplies, mounting brackets and consoles for police vehicles which are needed to support the Digital Vehicular Video Project.
