**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Memo for Item #34

Item #34 on the October 14, 2010 Council Agenda is to approve a resolution amending Resolution No. 021003-40 to add the Austin Trailer Food Festival 2010 event as a City Cosponsored special event for this year, waive certain requirements, and waive or reimburse certain fees for this event which is to be held on Saturday, November 6, 2010 at Auditorium Shores, has the following fiscal impact:

## Fees Waived:

\$8,542.38 Total Fees Waived

In summary, the total fees waived for this event are \$8,542.38. Additionally, the \$2,500 damage deposit requirement for Auditorium Shores is also being waived. Any fee requirements above this amount are the responsibility of the applicant.

At this time, this event is being added as a city co-sponsored special event for only FY 2010-11 per Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
