

**ORDINANCE NO. 20101028-045**

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING TEMPORARY VENDING PERMIT FEES UNDER CITY CODE CHAPTER 10 FOR THE 12<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GREEN CORN PROJECT FUNDRAISER HELD ON OCTOBER 24, 2010 AT THE BOGGY CREEK FARM.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Council finds that the Green Corn Project is a nonprofit corporation, its fundraiser is open to the public and serves the public purpose of promoting a healthy environment by reducing the use of toxic materials in gardening. This event also provides a family friendly civic activity.


**PART 2.** Council waives the requirement for temporary vending permit fees under City Code Section 10-3-64 for the Green Corn Project Fundraiser held on October 24, 2010 at Boggy Creek Farm in an amount not exceed \$840.


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
