Byrne-Reed House

1410 Rio Grande Street

Applicants: Ken Johnson, Clayton-Levy-Little, Architects

Humanities Texas, owners

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning. The restoration of the house is now complete.

Bones-Stokes House
1107 W. 9th Street
Applicants: Albert Percival, III and Kevin Hughes, owners

Staff Recommendation: Do not recommend historic zoning; the façade of the house has been significantly altered.
NOTE: The applicants are seeking a re-hearing of their case as they were not present at the time of the Commission's original recommendation, which was to deny historic zoning.
