MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission.

In September 2010, the City administratively awarded a contract to Rizzo and Associates, LLC., in the amount of \$29,870, to develop and deliver curriculum and training on the topics of diversity, inclusion, and cultural competence for the Austin Water Utility (AWU). The original goal was to provide training to the management and executive levels of the department.

Due to the success of this training, the target audience for this effort has now been expanded to include an additional 26 classes to approximately 800 remaining employees in AWU.
