ORDINANCE NO. <u>20101209-067</u>

AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE KNIPPA-HUFFMAN HOUSE LOCATED AT 2414 HARRIS BOULEVARD FROM FAMILY RESIDENCE (SF-3) DISTRICT TO FAMILY RESIDENCE-HISTORIC LANDMARK (SF-3-H) COMBINING DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from family residence (SF-3) district to family residence-historic landmark (SF-3-H) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14H-2010-0023, on file at the Planning and Development Review Department, as follows:



generally known as the Knippa-Huffman House, locally known as 2414 Harris Boulevard, in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit "A".
