SUBJECT: Fiscal Memo for Item #36

Item #36 on the January 13, 2011 Council Agenda is to approve an ordinance waiving certain fees and costs for the 2011 Austin Farmer's Markets, a City co-sponsored event, during the 2011 calendar year, has the following fiscal impact:

\$52,000	Park Rental Fees (Republic Square; \$1,000 x 52 weeks)

\$105,918	Total Fees Waived

In summary, the total fees waived for this event are \$105,918. Additionally, the \$2,000 refundable street closure deposit and the \$500 damage deposit requirement are also being waived. Any fee requirements above this amount are the responsibility of the applicant.

This is one of the city co-sponsored special events per Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
