John O'Brien, owner of FADO'S Irish Pub, has submitted a Street Event application for the closing of the following street for a fee paid event. The promoter will be charging a \$10.00 entry fee.

Street: 200 block of West 4th Street between Colorado Street and Lavaca Street

Closed: March 17, 2011 5:00 a.m.

Open: March 18, 2011 5:00 a.m.

Event Times: Thursday 10:00 a.m. – Midnight

Temporarily closing any portion of a street for a street event that requires the public to pay to enter the closure area requires City Council approval under Section 14-8-3 (B) of the City Code. The applicant is in the process of complying with all other requirements for this street event. The Austin Transportation Department recommends approval subject to the applicant complying with all other street closure requirements.

Fee Breakdown:

Amplified Sound Fee	-	\$ 33 x 1 day
Safety Inspection Fee	-	\$ 76 (\$38 per hour = 2 hours)
Security Deposit	-	\$2,000 (refundable upon written request)
Street Event Permit Fee	-	\$ 200 (\$100 per block x 2 days)
Total:		\$2,559.00
