## AUSTIN AREA BLACK CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION'S RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE UPCOMING AUSTIN ENERGY WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM

1.	AE Weatherization Program's business model described in the RFP document shall apply to
	all proposers

- AE's required Certifications (BP) Building Performance Institution and (RESNET) Residential Energy Services Network, shall apply to all proposers bidding as a General Contractor (No exceptions. Must apply to everyone)
- 3. MBE/WBE participation goals must be established and identified in the RFP's front end documents, i.e. ethnicity, gender percentages)
- 4. The roles and responsibilities of the weatherization contractor versus the auditor's (test-in and test-out) must clearly be identified in the RFP's documents
- 5. AE must supply their in-house Auditors with equipment to perform test-in and test-out since AE have appropriated 15% of the weatherization funds to the administration of this program.
- 6. When weatherization properties are identified by individual weatherization contractors, all participating weatherization contractors must be share equitable in allocations and providing the services according to the RFP)
- 7. The weatherization program should have a job creation requirement, specifically for low and moderate unemployed individuals residing in the targeted areas
- 8. Sanctions shall apply to the weatherization contractors who fail to comply with the MBE/WBE participation goals established for the program.

9.	Addendum/amendments /change orders that affect the any part of the program that affects directly the subcontractor must be shared with the subcontractor.
10.	. Weatherization contractors should not be allowed to perform auditing functions such as test-in and test-out without the BPI or RESNET Certifications.
