The Board of Directors will go into a closed session under Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code to receive advice from legal counsel, to discuss matters of land acquisition, to discuss personnel matters, or for other reasons permitted by law as specifically listed on this agenda. If necessary, the Board may go into a closed session as permitted by law regarding any item on this agenda.

1. Approve the minutes of the January 13 and February 10, 2011 Board meetings of the Austin Housing Finance Corporation.
2. Approve a resolution authorizing the issuance of Austin Housing finance Corporation Multi-Family Housing Revenue Bonds, in an amount not to exceed an aggregate principal amount of six million dollars in the form and substance of a trust indenture, a financing agreement, a regulatory agreement with respect to the project, and approve other matters in connection with the transaction to provide financing for the acquisition and rehabilitation of the Marshall Apartments, 1401 East 12th Street and 1157 Salina Street, to be owned and operated by MARSHALL AFFORDABLE PARTNERS, LTD, an affiliate of Summit Housing Partners, Inc., Montgomery AL, and authorize the Austin Housing Finance Corporation General Manager and the Austin Housing Finance Corporation Treasurer to execute the necessary documents to issue the bonds and close the transaction.
3. Approve a resolution authorizing the adoption and implementation of a Customer Privacy Assurance Program for the Austin Housing Finance Corporation.
