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Proposal for the Austin Fire Department for Collapse Rescue Operations Course

The Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) Urban Search & Rescue Division (US&R) is pleased to offer the Austin Fire Department the Collapse Rescue Operations 50 hour course to be held at our Disaster City® location in College Station, Texas. The Austin Fire Department will occupy a minimum of 28 and a maximum of 36 places in the April 11th-15th, 2011 open enrollment class.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Collapse Rescue Operations course is 50 hours, five days in length, ten hours of instruction each day, and is designed to provide participants with the operational knowledge, skills and abilities to perform rescue at structural collapse scenes due to natural disasters or human forces. This course meets and exceeds NFPA 1670 for structural collapse operations. In addition, this course completes the requirements for structural collapse technician NFPA 1006 when combined with the ICS pre-requisites and knowledge, skills and abilities in search of collapse structures, heavy rigging, and pre hospital EMS skills.

COURSE COSTS

The following table provides the costs for TEEX US&R delivery of the above course at out Disaster City ® location in College Station, TX.

COURSE DELIVERY NOTES:

Austin Fire Department will be responsible for providing:

- A minimum of 28 students for the duration of the class.
- Any additional students up to a maximum of 36 can be added at the open enrollment price of \$2,000.00 each.
- The students' names and enrollment information 14 days before the start of the class March 18th, 2011.
- Payment in full within 30 days of class completion.

TEEX US&R will be responsible for providing:

- Instructors, supplies, and consumables needed for the classes.
- A TEEX certificate of course completion for each student.

This is a non-binding proposal and the prices listed on page 1 will remain valid until December 31, 2010. Upon acceptance of this proposal a contract will be prepared and executed prior to the scheduling of training. Note: All Open enrollment classes are subject to the TEEX transfers and cancellations policy.
