Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the Transportation Fund, Austin Transportation Department. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
