ANALYSIS / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Funding of up to \$285,000 will be provided by the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (CMTA). In coordination with the CMTA, the Austin Transportation Department proposes to provide prioritization to transit vehicles operating within the planned Metro Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) routes. The technology tracks a user's (bus or emergency vehicle) location and sends a priority call to a traffic signal as the user approaches.
