<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Homeowners living on the priority area</li> <li>• The assistance will be in the form of a grant</li> <li>• Not to exceeds \$10,000.</li> <li>• No income restrictions.</li> <li>• <b>Total projects under those guidelines: 120</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eligible households may earn no more than 80% percent of Area Median Family</li> <li>• Only one repair service was allowed per household</li> <li>• Applicant must have occupied and claimed as applicant's homestead</li> <li>• Two years of residence</li> <li>• Current on all property taxes</li> <li>• Assistance: loan to grant not to exceed \$25,000 forgiven after 10 years</li> <li>• Reconstruction option up to \$100,000.</li> <li>• <b>Total projects under those guidelines: 3</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reduced loan term: deferred loans of up to \$30,000 that may be forgiven after 7 years.</li> <li>• Established five program options: exterior painting, plumbing, electrical, solar panels and/or roof repairs.</li> <li>• Eliminated option for home demolition and reconstruction.</li> <li>• Provide additional assistance to those residents who received previous services.</li> <li>• Eligible households may earn no more than 100 percent of Area Median Family Income</li> <li>• Establish applicant or immediate family member owned the home in 2003 existed previously.); and</li> <li>• Homes receiving repairs must be the principal residence of the homeowner.</li> <li>• <b>Total complete projects under those guidelines: 1</b></li> <li>• <b>Closing projects: 4</b></li> <li>• <b>Under bid process: 14</b></li> </ul>
