

RESOLUTION NO. 20110623-045

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for and acceptance of \$50,000 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to the Austin Police Department, "City of Austin Anti-Gang Youth Apprenticeship Program," to launch a pilot apprenticeship program for gang-affiliated youth citywide; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for and acceptance of grant renewal funds for said project in the amount of \$50,000 from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to launch a pilot apprenticeship program for gang-affiliated youth citywide; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and



The City Council approves the application for and acceptance of grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to the Austin Police Department, "City of Austin Anti-Gang Youth Apprenticeship Program," in the amount of \$50,000.
