ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a preventive program that targets women and children below 185% of federal poverty level. The WIC Program provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and nutritious foods to pregnant women, infants, and children up to age five. There will be \$252,423 of these funds targeted to the Breastfeeding Peer Counselor area, \$17,844 for Dietetic Internship, \$8,000 for Registered Dietitian and an additional \$3,000 targeted for the mini-obesity projects that include the Walk with WIC, Wok with WIC, and Montopolis WIC Garden projects. The entire grant award of \$5,000 is appropriated in the fiscal year of the grant's start date. The General Fund will not be required to contribute to this grant.
