Authorize execution of a construction contract with ASPHALT PAVING COMPANY OF AUSTIN, INC., Buda, TX, for the 2011 Miscellaneous Streets Overlay - Phase 3 project in the amount of \$2,664,758.67 plus a \$266,475.86 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,931,234.53.

Additional Backup Information

The purpose of this project is to provide maintenance and repairs on approximately 47.55 lane miles of streets throughout Austin. The work includes all necessary street preparation work including milling, crack sealing, hot mix asphaltic concrete (HMAC) surface replacement and HMAC level up, followed by the installation of an asphalt overlay. The streets identified for this project are in need of strengthening and smoothing as determined by the Pavement Management Information System which assesses the existing condition and riding comfort of the streets. Along with the condition assessment, the identification process included coordination with utilities for any planned work in the areas.

The recommended contract amount includes the acceptance of Alternate # 1, which includes 8.36 of the 47.55 miles of street preparation and overlay work. Due to the potential for unknown utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. The contract allows for 70 calendar days for completion of this project.
