Amount and Source of Funding

Additional Backup Information

This contract with Love Tennis is for the management and operation of Caswell Tennis Center for the Parks and Recreation Department. The tennis center provides quality tennis instruction for the citizens of Austin. The Parks and Recreation Department currently does not have the staff for the level of tennis instruction, operation and experience to manage a tennis center. Caswell Tennis Center includes eight lighted courts and one lighted backboard. Love Tennis shall manage the collections of court fees, court reservations, provision of lessons and tennis programs. Love Tennis shall be allowed to use half the courts for programming of lessons and clinics for a court fee rate approved by the City. Love Tennis also agrees to support the use of the facility by the Austin Independent School District (AISD) for special events during the school year. There is no charge for AISD to use these courts. The City shall pay a monthly management fee to Love Tennis for the management and operation of Caswell Tennis Center.
