This contract with Ellery McLanahan Tennis Inc. is for the management and operation of Pharr Tennis Center for the Parks and Recreation Department. The tennis center provides quality tennis instruction for the citizens of Austin. The Parks and Recreation Department currently does not have the staff for the level of tennis instruction, operation and experience to manage a tennis center. Pharr Tennis Center includes eight lighted courts and one lighted backboard. Ellery McLanahan shall manage the collections of court fees, court reservations, provision of lessons and tennis programs. Ellery McLanahan shall be allowed to use half the courts for programming of lessons and clinics for a court fee rate approved by the City. Ellery McLanahan also agrees to support the use of the facility by the Austin Independent School District (AISD) for special events during the school year.
